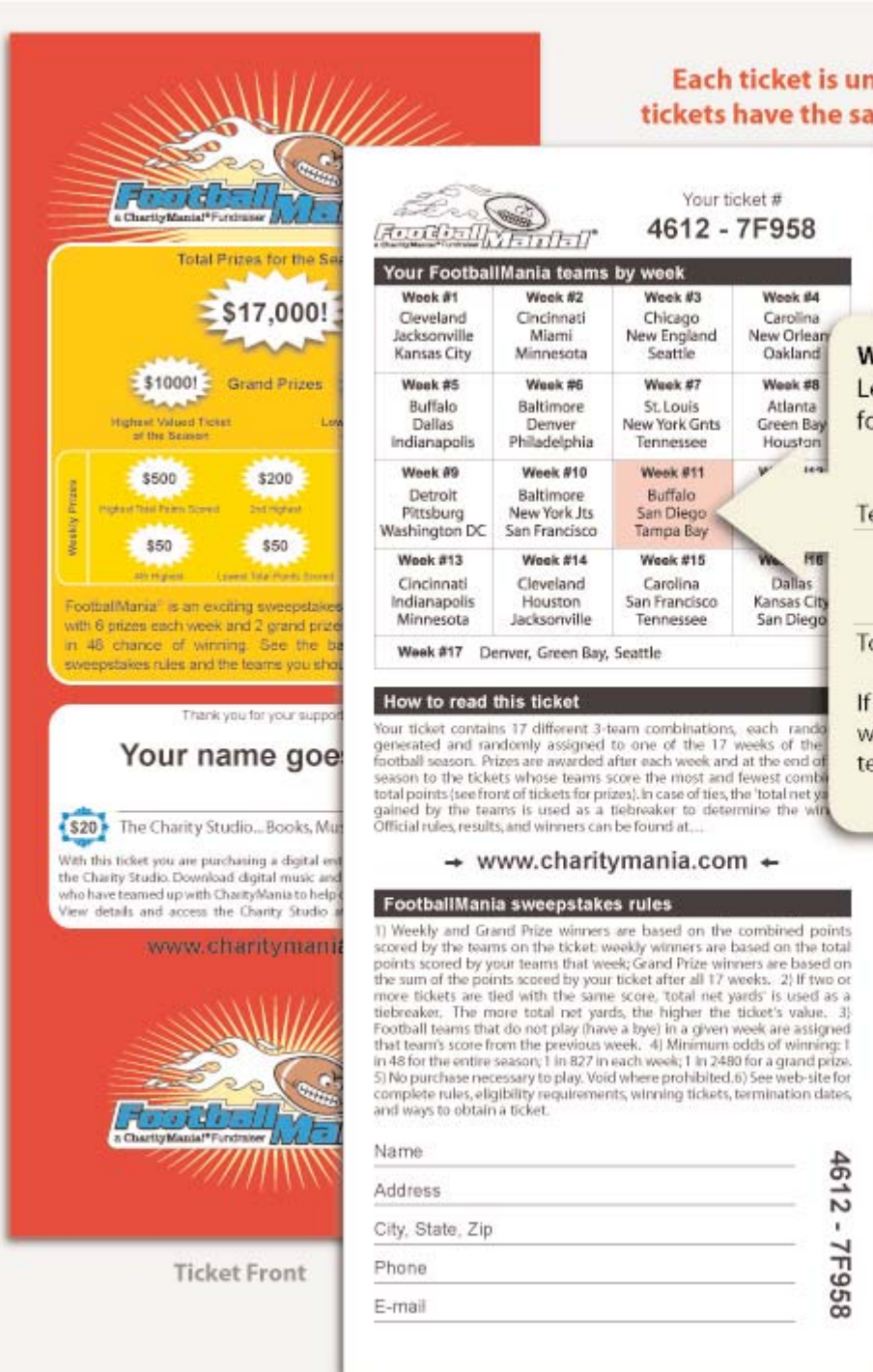


SAMPLE TICKET

Each ticket is eligible to win all 17 weeks of the season!

Winning ticket (example)

Let's say your ticket has the following 3 teams in week 11:

Team	Points scored in week 11
Buffalo	31
San Diego	24
Tampa Bay	28

Total Points scored **83**

If your 3 randomly assigned teams were the 3 highest or lowest scoring teams that week, then you win!

How to read this ticket

Your ticket contains 17 different 3-team combinations, each randomly generated and randomly assigned to one of the 17 weeks of the football season. Prizes are awarded after each week and at the end of the season to the tickets whose teams score the most and fewest combined total points (see front of tickets for prizes). In case of ties, the "total net yards" gained by the teams is used as a tiebreaker to determine the winner. Official rules, results, and winners can be found at...

FootballMania sweepstakes rules

1) Weekly and Grand Prize winners are based on the combined points scored by the teams on the ticket; weekly winners are based on the total points scored by your teams that week; Grand Prize winners are based on the sum of the points scored by your ticket after all 17 weeks. 2) If two or more tickets are tied with the same score, "total net yards" is used as a tiebreaker. The more total net yards, the higher the ticket's value. 3) Football teams that do not play (have a bye) in a given week are assigned that team's score from the previous week. 4) Minimum odds of winning: 1 in 48 for the entire season; 1 in 827 in each week; 1 in 2480 for a grand prize. 5) No purchase necessary to play.
